LEARNING OUTCOME

Children love to be creative and use their imagination whilst exploring other cultures, so let's learn with this cricket themed activity that supports diversity.

STARTER ACTIVITY

Find out information about a country that plays cricket. Produce a fact file on each country and present to the rest of the family. This could also be done for cricketing counties in UK.

MAIN ACTIVITY

Develop themes to explore population trends for nationalities in the county ground cricketing venues. E.g. how many different nationalities living in Nottingham, where Trent Bridge is?

TOP TIPS

There is a lot of information out there, use the ECB website, ICC website or individual county cricket board sites.

EXTENSION ACTIVITY

What different religions are found in the UK? What about the religions of the cricketing countries from the presentations? How do cricketers manage their religious beliefs whilst on tour/ playing matches, e.g. Coping with fasting periods, praying, etc.
