LEARNING OUTCOME

Children love to be creative and use their imagination, so let's learn with this cricket themed activity that supports art and design. Apply your imagination to create an amazing piece of sports equipment for professional cricketers to use.

STARTER ACTIVITY

On your own or with a partner, search online for cricket bat designs, how they are made and what materials they use. What makes them so good that the professionals want to use them? What material are they made of? What are the dimensions or sizes of bats for different age groups? Do they vary in weight? How could you make them even better?

MAIN ACTIVITY

Design your own cricket bat. Think about what colours or material you'd use, patterns/ design and any extra bits that you feel would make this kit the best bat the England Cricket team will ever use! Use the ideas you got from your research as a starting point.

TOP TIPS

Make your bat eye catching, be creative, think about whether your bat is for a country or a team and search some of the best bats online for inspiration.

EXTENSION ACTIVITY

Can you make your bat with some amazing bits of design/ technology that have never been seen before! E.g. rocket fuel technology to hit the ball even further!
