



## COVID-19 GUIDANCE FAQs

MARCH 2021

**1. What are the likely travel restrictions early in the season?**

In England, we are awaiting more information in the announcement due on or around 22<sup>nd</sup> March, however the Government message is clear to Stay at Home until the 29<sup>th</sup> March. Sport England have produced some advice on travel which can be found [here](#)

In Wales, the Welsh Government requirement is to stay local, usually within 5 miles, but more information can be found [here](#)

**2. When is the full guidance expected to be released and why is the Welsh guidance already in circulation?**

As Wales has a devolved Government they have the responsibility to make decisions on the easing of lockdown restrictions in Wales. The Welsh Government is undertaking a review of the current Alert Level and restrictions on a three-weekly basis.

The UK Government have shared the roadmap to ease lockdown restrictions, the next update is expected on or around 22<sup>nd</sup> March, we will then review the implications and update our guidance accordingly, sharing more publicly as soon as we are comfortable in doing so.
