Information obtained when discussing your expression of interest with you such as: experience, availability, activity levels, employment type and any specific requirements you may have. Additional information obtained if you are successful in securing a volunteer role such as date of birth, full contact details, address, DBS status, kit size(s) (if relevant), emergency phone number, feedback and references.
Sources of personal data	You. Any person who provides a reference for you. Any person providing feedback about you.
Automated decisions	None.
Purposes of processing	The ECB will process your personal data for the purposes of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assessing and administering your expression of interest for a volunteer role as an activator and other volunteering roles and contacting you about sessions for which you are selected.• Quality and improvement monitoring.• Reporting of participation and of figures and trends in the interest of cricket participation.• Diversity monitoring and compliance (such as in respect of ethnicity, gender, race, age and disability) and providing equal opportunities.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notifying you of other volunteer roles and other opportunities to get involved in cricket if you agree to this (this may involve profiling). • Obtaining insurance and ensuring safety and security for you and those attending sessions.
Who we will disclose your personal data to	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Relevant County Cricket Boards/Club(s)/Centre(s). • The ECB's official kit and equipment logistics partner of our Children's Programme (currently DMC Sport) to arrange for delivery of kit and to contact you about this. • Complainants. • Insurers, legal and other professional advisers (as applicable). • Regulators and law enforcement (as applicable).
Legal basis for processing your personal data	<p>The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • assessment, administration, insurance, safety and security: that it is necessary to fulfil the contract that you are going to enter into or have entered into with us. • contacting you about other roles and opportunities: that you have given your consent. • diversity monitoring: that it is necessary for us to comply with the law and/or that it is necessary for the purposes of quality of opportunity and/or that you have given your explicit consent. • in all other cases: that it is necessary for our legitimate interests which are to help regulate the sport of cricket, develop and implement cricket initiatives and to ensure and to ensure that the reputation of cricket is preserved, and this does not prejudice or harm your rights and freedoms, or that it is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.
Your right to withdraw consent	<p>Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it.</p>
Direct marketing	<p>We hope you would like to hear from us about other opportunities in cricket and to tailor our communications to suit what we think you will find interesting and relevant (profiling).</p> <p>You can choose the information you receive by selecting your preferences on your expression of interest. You can change your mind at any time.</p>
Location of your personal data	<p>The ECB will normally keep your personal data within the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area. However, in connection with your expression of interest, the ECB's service provider, Microsoft, will hold the personal data on your form in the USA where it will be protected in accordance with the EU-US privacy shield principles and/or by using Standard Contractual Clauses.</p>
How long we will keep your personal data for	<p>We will normally keep your personal data for up to 6 years. After this time, we will anonymise your information, pool it with anonymised information about others in ECB programmes and use the anonymised data for analysis of engagement trends.</p>
Your rights in respect of your personal data	<p>You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.</p>
